"Knowing a person is like music - what attracts us is the melody - as we get to know who they are, we learn the lyrics." (Dean Ray)



Joe has been invited to speak at and host thousands of prestigious, professional and private events, over his long media career.



ALL AROUND CANADIAN AUCTIONEER'S CHAMPIONSHIP COMPETITION.

The Auctioneer's Association of Alberta invite's all Canadian accredited auctioneers to the "2023 All Around Canadian Auctioneer's Championship Competition". The competition will be held in conjunction with the annual Auctioneer's Assoc. of Ab. convention in Red Deer, Alberta. It is being held at the Holiday Inn and Suites – Red Deer South.

The convention runs from Thursday, February 2nd to Saturday, February 4th, 2023.

All accredited auctioneers in Canada will be eligible to compete on Saturday Feb. 4th, 2023.

1st place will receive a custom trophy belt buckle plus \$ 3000.00 cash

2nd place will receive a custom trophy belt buckle and \$ 1000.00 cash

3rd place will receive a custom trophy belt buckle and \$500.00 cash

Judges will consist of

- 1- Livestock orientated judge
- 1- Auto orientated judge
- 1- Heavy Equipment orientated judge
- 1- General Merchandise orientated judge
- 1- Professional Auction Clerk

Contestants / Judges and Sponsors will be introduced after the banquet and Tyro competition on Friday evening. Each auctioneer will draw for selling order at this time.

The top and bottom scores will be discarded, and placements will be based on the average of 3 judges.

First round contestants will sell 4 lot's consisting of 2 items supplied by the auctioneer and 2 items supplied by the Association. Auctioneers will sell their own supplied items.

The top 5 contestants will be brought back for the final round selling 4-items that will be supplied by the Association. The winners will be announced at the banquet on Saturday night and presentations made.

With innovations within the Auction Industry nationwide, this year will include on-line bidding, and points will be awarded Auctioneers who can utilize both live bidding and bidding from the online screen. The online broadcast and online bidding will be sponsored & facilitated by Can-Bid.

Entry fee is \$ 350.00 payable to The Alberta Auctioneer's Association. Payment can be made by mailed in cheque or online e-transfer. Contact Leoni Philp (403-340-2070) at the Auction Association office in Carstairs.

This will include convention fee's, banquet tickets and competition.

Entry's will be accepted only until January 15th, 2023, with no exceptions made.

To make this a fair and impartial competition no member of the Committee will compete in the competition who has any part in judge selection or accounting of scores.

No competitor will be allowed to use the mic before the competition. Each auctioneer will be invited to the mic for a pre-sale mic check. The mic will be set at 1 level and will not be changed.

Previous champions of this contest are ineligible for competition.

Auctioneeers Association of Alberta Scholarship Program

The Auctioneers Association of Alberta awards up to 2 scholarships of \$500 each year. One to a member of the Association who has recently attended or will be attending an auction school and the other to a child or grandchild of an association member pursuing post secondary education.

For auctioneers, if you are planning on attending an accredited auction school, you may apply for a scholarship and the scholarship will be awarded upon completion of the qualifying criteria. The qualifying criteria for the scholarship are:

- 1) Graduated from an accredited auctioneering school within 1 year of the application date.
- 2) A member of the Auctioneers Association of Alberta.
- 3) Have competed in Tyro competition.
- 4) Have completed Alberta Auctions 101 and 201 professional development courses.
- 5) Have attended at least one annual convention and annual general meeting of the Association.

For those applying for the general scholarship you must have a parent or grandparent that is a member of the Association and be enrolled at post secondary institution. You must be nominated by the association member.
